- A co-funded European Union (EU) programme
- COM refers to community and PACT to the stakeholder relationship
- 3 implementing partners (2 South African and 1 international)
- Aimed at enhancing local government planning and accountability through public participation

COMPACT is jointly implemented by the Public Affairs Research Institute (**PARI**), the South African Local Government Association (**SALGA**) and Integrity Action (**IA**).

The aim is to:

- Achieve a more responsive and accountable local government and to deepen democracy.
- **I Enhance participation** of local communities in the IDP processes, with particular emphasis on water and sanitation services.
- I Improve planning and oversight of service delivery in municipalities
